To Live Gracefully I Must...

1) Willingly sacrifice \_\_\_\_\_

*Season all your grain offerings with salt. Do not leave the salt of the covenant of your God out of your grain offerings; add salt to all your offerings. Leviticus 2:13 (NIV)*

*Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. Colossians 4:6 (NIV)*

3) \_\_\_\_\_ Gracefully

*For everyone will be salted with fire. Mark 9:49 (ESV)*

*"Everyone's going through a refining fire sooner or later, but you'll be well-preserved, protected from the eternal flames. Be preservatives yourselves. Preserve the peace." Mark 9:49-50 (MSG)*
